



6TH Grade Summer Reading

Students will read the novel *A Long Walk to Water* by Linda Sue Park.

Materials: copy paper or similar size blank paper, pencil, coloring utensils, and novel

Assignment: You will produce a one-pager based on the novel. A one-pager is a single-page response to your reading. It is a way to communicate your understanding of the material in a unique way. A one -pager allows you to be creative and experimental. It gives you the opportunity to respond to your reading imaginatively and honestly. This assignment is due the Friday of the first week of school.

Directions:

1. **Include all of the following activities on your one-pager.**
 - a. Title and author
 - b. Include three quotes or phrases. Explain what they mean in a sentence.
 - c. Include three visual images. Your pictures should represent the story. Write a sentence with each picture explaining the picture.
 - d. Write a connection you have with the story. It could be a text-to-self connection, a text-to-world connection, or a text-to-text connection. Explain the connection in a sentence.
 - e. Write a short description about one of the characters. Include three-character traits and why the character exhibits each character trait.
2. **Be neat and organized in your one-pager.**
