Service Hours Instructions

OBJECTIVE

RSCA seeks to teach students how to serve effectively. The accountability and structure presented in the service project provide a proper framework within which to accomplish this goal. The importance of service is integrated into the fabric of our Bible classes and students will demonstrate their understanding of the biblical mandate to serve through completion of their service project.

REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete a total of 100 hours of service throughout their High School career as a graduation requirement by completing at least 25 hours each year during their enrollment at RSCA. Students may “work ahead” to complete those 100 hours, but may NOT lag behind and try to complete them all at the end of high school.

- These service projects may NOT be family household chores, but must be to benefit someone outside of the nuclear family unit.
- Students must have the Service Accountability form (see below) with them at the time of service so that the beneficiary or supervisor of the service can provide the expected feedback and signature.
- Students must provide a brief description of the service performed, including what they learned by serving.
- The form requires a parental signature as well, but the parent may NOT sign as the supervisor of the service activity.
- **If multiple service projects are involved, with various supervisors, the students should submit a separate Service Accountability form for each activity.**
- Service hours should be completed between the end of the previous school year and first Friday of May..
- **Service Accountability form(s) is(are) due by or before the first Friday of May.** Extensions will only be granted in extreme circumstances and must be requested in advance of the deadline by contacting the Upper School Principal. *Students that have not completed their service hours by this deadline will be required to remain after school and complete their hours by performing service projects at RSCA.*
